

The "Kjeld Brodsgaard Sportsmanship" Award

The Kjeld Brodsgaard Sportsmanship Award was created to honor a BCWOA Official who lead official's by setting a very high standard of professionalism, citizenship, exemplifying Sportsmanship and fair play. Kjeld officiated in the 2000 Sydney and 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games.

The Kjeld Brodsgaard Sportsmanship Award is to be presented annually to two high school wrestlers (1 Male, 1 Female). The winners will each receive a bursary of \$100 each to assist them in attending the National Championships. The winner of the award will be selected mainly based on their display of Good Sportsmanship and Citizenship throughout the season

Criteria for Application:

1. Must be a BCWA member athlete who is traveling to compete in the Juvenile Division at the Cadet & Juvenile National Championships.
2. Include a list of citizenship credentials. How you assisted wrestling this season. (Volunteer work, officiating, tournament assistance, school grades, etc)
3. The applicant needs to complete the attached application and attach a one page wrestling resume from the past season indicating why they qualify for this award. The coach should sign the letter attesting to the athlete's sportsmanship, leadership and citizenship.
